

Troubleshooting

First things first

- Disable any overclocking!
- Add Kryptex to the Antivirus exclusion list
- Update your GPU drivers: NVIDIA GeForce | AMD Radeon
- Make sure you have enough virtual memory:
 Set page file size to be equal to the amount of total GPU memory of all cards combined
- Re-run Kryptex benchmark

Check the Network

- Use a cable to directly connect your PC to a network
- Add Kryptex to the Firewall exceptions
- Try using a <u>VPN</u>

BIOS setup

- Turn on "Above 4G Decoding" in BIOS
- Try setting PCIe speed to 2.0 or 1.1
- Turn the integrated GPU off



Other issues

Got multiple GPUs? Turn SLI or Crossfire off

Got AMD+NVIDIA combined? Leave GPUs of one manufacturer only

Got Windows 10? Install the <u>Anniversary Update</u>

Got AMD cards older than RX5/RX4**?** Use <u>Catalyst 15.12 driver</u>

Got Nvidia 750(Ti) or 9xx?

Turn on "Optimize for compute" and set "DSR-Factors" to 2.0x using Nvidia Control Panel
